





FY22 Statement of Financial Position



In June 2021, Arts Midwest received an unrestricted \$8,000,000 gift from MacKenzie Scott. We are planning to allocate these funds over 5+ years for programs, innovation, and infrastructure. Our 2022 deficit includes: \$517,583 of program and infrastructure spending from MacKenzie Scott gift, \$287,930 in fees incurred for conference cancellations, \$93,925 for onetime projects like an office move, and \$1,209,443 from investment losses, of which \$1,149,350 are unrealized losses.


